

LENGTH of WARRANTY

This warranty begins on the day that you purchase your sleep set. Remember to keep your sales receipt as proof of purchase and *do not remove the Law Tag* from your sleep set. Your receipt and Law Tag will serve as a means of establishing your warranty rights. In the unlikely event that you ever have a problem with your sleep set, its Limited Warranty would not be renewed or extended after repair or replacement of the original set. *If you have a problem, contact the Martin dealer where you purchased the set.* They will be able to answer questions regarding your warranty. *Stains, burns or abuse of the mattress or foundation will void the warranty.* The length of your warranty may be determined by matching the Warranty Code found on the Law Tag of your sleep set with the corresponding information on the Warranty Schedule found below.

WARRANTY SCHEDULES

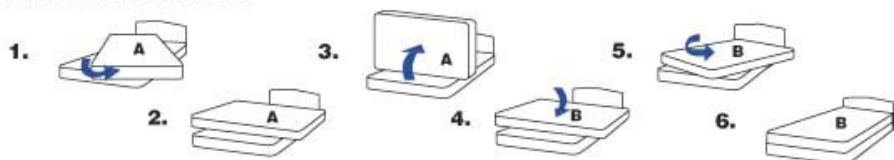

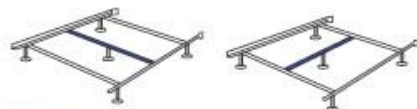
You have just purchased a quality sleep product from Martin Mattress. In order to prolong the life of your bed and be more satisfied with its overall performance, ***Please Remember the Following Points!***

- 1) *Body impressions are normal in quality bedding.* They indicate that the upholstery layers are conforming to your body's individual contours. These are not structural defects but normal occurrences in the superior performance of the mattress.
- 2) Impressions are going to be more noticeable on King and Queen sizes.
- 3) To equalize impressions turn your mattress over and end to end regularly, every two weeks for the first three months of use, every two months thereafter:



If you own a Martin *single-sided* mattress, *you do not need to turn the mattress over*, but it should be rotated periodically. If your particular mattress shows signs of body impressions in between these scheduled rotations, feel free to change the schedule so that you will always be sleeping on a comfortable surface.

- 4) This mattress is covered under warranty and is certified for sale as a set with a matching **FR-Certified** Martin foundation and requires use on a proper frame with a center support. This warranty covers sleep sets only. It will be null and void if the Martin mattress is not used on a matching Martin Mattress foundation with a proper frame that has a rigid center support. Here are examples of recommended bed frames for King and Queen size sleep sets:



Tips to Extend the Life of Your Mattress:

- 1) We recommend a quilted protector pad be placed on your mattress to act as a barrier against stains to the mattress. *Stains, burns or abuse of the mattress or foundation will void the warranty.*
- 2) Mattress handles are provided for positioning your mattress on the foundation only. Handles may pull out if used to support the full weight of the mattress when carrying or turning.
- 3) Do not use dry cleaning fluid on your mattress since it will cause damage.

LIMITED WARRANTY

Martin Mattress warrants that this sleep set will be free from *manufacturing defects*. PLEASE NOTE: Martin Mattress agrees to repair or replace any factory defective piece of a sleep set but *will not* repair or replace the matching piece unless it is also defective. Additionally, the Limited Warranty is provided **ONLY** to the original purchaser of the sleep set, and proof of purchase is required.

In the unlikely event that you ever have a problem with your Martin mattress, please contact the dealer who sold you the set. Martin Mattress retailers handle all warranty claims, returns and exchanges.

What is NOT Covered?

The following items are **NOT** covered:

- 1) ***Due to Health Concerns ...*** mattresses or foundations that are stained, soiled, burned or abused will void this warranty.
- 2) Border wires (which run along the perimeter of the mattress and foundation) bent due to moving or bending of the sleep set.
- 3) Structural damage to the mattress or foundation due to the use of an improper bed frame. King and Queen size sets should rest on a frame with a rigid center support having at least one center leg.
- 4) Impressions of 2" or greater on *only one side* of the mattress (unless the mattress is a *single-sided* Martin mattress in which case only the top side of the mattress needs to have an impression in excess of 2" to be covered).
- 5) Mattress damage due to the use of a non-matching foundation. A Martin mattress is designed for full performance when used in conjunction with a matching Martin foundation.
- 6) Replacement of a matching piece in the sleep set, unless such other piece is also defective.
- 7) Transportation/freight or shipping costs. *It is the responsibility of the consumer to pay ALL transportation, freight, and shipping costs when returning a defective Martin product to or picking up a replacement product from a Martin dealer. In the event the Authorized Martin dealer is out of business, consumers are responsible for picking up replacement product from the nearest Martin manufacturing facility or paying all costs associated with delivery of replacement product via common carrier.*

A Martin FR Bed compliant with CFR 1633

Martin mattresses produced after July 1, 2007 conform to the Federal flammability standard known as **16 CFR Part 1633**. Every Martin **FR** mattress is certified to be sold alone (mattress only) or in a set with a certified Martin **FR** foundation. Please Note: *A FR-Certified mattress may NOT be sold with a foundation that was not tested and certified for use under that particular Martin mattress.* Refer to the **FR** Law Tag on the mattress for information on the specific Martin foundation that may lawfully be sold with your new Martin mattress.
